Aim: In the new school year Bulgaria is expected to begin the introduction of inclusive education under the Law on pre-school and school education throughout the school system. At present many general education teachers are not well prepared to provide training to all of their students with various learning difficulties, socially marginalized communities, students in conflict with the law, children from refugee families and others. The training will offer participants various tools to support and work directly with students with different profiles and cultural diversity. It is envisaged to present to participants the opportunities for educational mobility within the Erasmus + programme.
