1- AFNAMOC Project Introduction:

Because of current Syrian crisis that most Syrian people are suffering from in Syria, Jordan and Lebanon, the role of local NGOs is very crucial for helping refugees and Syrians living all around those countries to be able to go back to their normal life activities and rebuild their society again based on modern social perspectives of trust and respect of each other. As more local NGOs are involved in helping Syrians across those countries, and as most of those NGOs and associations don't have enough knowledge and experience in managing and administrating such operations, the outcomes of activities from those NGOs and charity associations is not optimized to reach their goals and objectives efficiently for helping Syrians.

Moreover, during the Syrian crisis within the last four years, two training initiatives were launched for local NOGs and relevant associations in order to develop management and administrative staff working at those NGOs. Such initiatives were funded by international donors like World Health Organization (WHO) and another international NGO and the training were administrated by local and regional trainers at local and regional training centers. The training targeted only about 1% of total local NGOs and relevant associations in these countries. Yet, as information was gathered from surveys and training feedback from those trained NGOs; the outcomes of such training was not effective enough since the training methodology and training curriculum is poorly developed by local trainers and was not based on relevant academic experience to manage and administer these kinds of associations. Another challenge for such development and training programs was to reach more

NGOs and local relevant associations and to enforce the application of management training in those organizations by training not only the working employees but also the board members of those NGOs and associations since those members are the real decision makers in their organizations in order to let the working staff practice what they have learned from such training.

As a result, **AFNAMOC** Academic Framework for **N**GO Administrative, **M**anagement and **O**rganizational **C**apacity Building and Development project aims at building capacity for NGOs and other local relevant associations in Syria, Lebanon and Jordan and developing the (KSA matrix) Knowledge, Skills and Attitudes of board members and working employees in these organizations in order to optimize the benefits from their activities that will reach almost all Syrian people in those countries. To be more effective, such training and academic programs should be provided in a standard academic framework for board members, executives and other employees working in these organizations.

In brief, the need for such project in Syria, Lebanon and Jordan is due to current Syrian crisis to develop NGOs work and activities efficiently for short and long-terms to support Syrians living across those countries.

2- AFNAMOC Project Objectives:

- **a.** Creating and developing an integrated training programs for all managerial and governance needs for NGOs and relevant associations.
- **b.** Creating academic programs specialized in management and governance of NGOs (undergraduate and postgraduate levels) nationally and internationally through joint program studies.

3- AFNAMOC Project Goals (Effects and Desired Results):

- a. Capacity building for academic staff and employees at regional participated universities (Syrian, Lebanese and Jordanian).
- b. Creating joint degree programs (applied and research degree).
- c. Developing related curricula for NGO Management and development studies.

- d. Raising the accreditation level of SHIIASR-AKFB (Ahmad Kuftaro Foundation Branch) and other partner universities as professional higher education institutions locally, regionally and internationally for related NGO management and development studies.
- e. Establishing a specialized career management center for NGO management and development studies at SHIIASR-SAKFB to support students and their career and developing the academic staff.
- f. Developing specialized relevant Executive Program for training NGOs board members and top executives.
- g. Developing specialized relevant academic program for postgraduate studies of NGO management and development studies.
- h. Developing specialized relevant academic program for undergraduate university level of NGO management and development studies.
