It was established in September 1983 and accredited by the Government of Turkmenistan with a capacity of 2149 students.</p> <p>Students receive training at 3 faculties: Faculty of Romance-Germanic Languages and Literature, Faculty of Oriental Languages and Literature, and Faculty of Russian language and Literature.</p> <p>The ATNIWL Institute teaching staff is involved in working out the curricula, textbooks, manuals, and audiovisual aids in different languages. They have been able to develop programs and specializations in line with the needs of the Turkmen society and many of them are co-authors and editors of textbooks for HEIs, schools and kindergartens.</p> <p>The country's integration into the world political and economic relations has become the main reasons stimulating the demand for thoroughly prepared translators and the development of translation profession in Turkmenistan. Seydi)</b> (TSPI) trains teachers of all school subjects and teachers for kindergartens. The Institute took</p>



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	<p>part in working out the qualification characteristics of secondary education teachers and also in drawing up the state standards of higher education in Turkmenistan. The experienced teaching staff has worked out the curricula approved by the Ministry of Education and the Government of Turkmenistan. Based on them, the corresponding syllabi and textbooks have been compiled by its staff members.</p> <p>Internationalisation is one of the important directions of the TSPI strategy. Since 2015, in line with the Agreement on cooperation in education sphere between the Governments of Turkmenistan and Afghanistan, the TSPI has offered free preparatory training and language courses, as well as higher education in various teaching disciplines to Afghan citizens who live under difficult social, economic and demographic conditions to render all possible assistance to the neighbouring country in training the qualified personnel.</p> <p>TSPI took active part in Tempus projects.</p> <p><b>International University for the Humanities and Development (IUHD)</b> is one of the newest Universities in Turkmenistan and was founded by the President of Turkmenistan Gurbanguly Berdimuhamedov in September, 2014. This is the first higher educational institution in Turkmenistan to offer Bachelor and Master degrees fully in English.</p> <p>At the Bachelor course IUHD currently offers 14 majors in six faculties. All of the fields of study and specializations have their own curriculum, qualification that meets the requirements and standards of the Ministry of Education of Turkmenistan. As a newly established University it enrolls more than 1000 students, and employs about 70 teachers and lecturers.</p> <p>There are two language-related departments at IUHD.</p> <p>The Language Learning Department which is an English language-focused foundation course, that offers training for the Bachelor studies in English from the elementary level of English to the Intermediate level.</p> <p>Second one is the Foreign Languages Department offers English for specific purposes courses to all major of the Bachelor level studies and other foreign languages including Japanese, Chinese, Italian and others as an Elective course.</p> <p>IUHD is a member of the United Nations Academic Impact Initiative. It has agreements on academic cooperation and exchange with the Wright State University (USA), IMC University of Applied Sciences, Austria, Tokyo University for Foreign Studies (Japan), Sungkyunkwan University (South Korea), MSU, Malaysia, and Institute of Peace Studies, Pakistan.</p> <p>IUHD has an ambition to become a national brand for academic excellence by building a university nurtured in the best academic traditions. It is determined to become a recognized modern scientific institution offering state-of-the-art, learning-centered technology and learning resources. It offers admission to the international students, and invites visiting professors from partner-universities.
