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PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Objectives and Overview:

The main objective and mission of the university are to support the internationalization of the university by developing and maintaining strong partnerships with universities at the European level. These relationships will support the growth, transfer, and implementation of innovative practices as well as joint initiatives promoting cooperation, peer learning and exchange of experience for both students and professors or staff.

The German Jordanian University (GJU) is one of Jordan's leading universities. It is a public university located in Mushaqar that was founded in 2005 by a Royal Decree, in accordance with a memorandum of understanding between the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the Federal Ministry of Education and Research of the Federal Republic of Germany.

This university is the result of strong academic cooperation between Jordan and Germany, and GJU is an exhibit of the German applied sciences model by being closely linked to industry. German Jordanian University has grown in both size and stature over the past few years, It offers over 20 programs with all programs are taught in English, with a student body of around 5,000, from more than 30 nationalities and around 47 incoming exchange students in spring 2019. The majority of GJU students are enrolled in the technical majors and schools which makes your respectful university an interesting partner to collaborate with.

We provide our students with opportunities to learn to function successfully and with ease in a global environment, this is done mainly by having our students travel to Germany for their fourth year of study. All of the German Jordanian University's programs contain a mandatory year abroad in Germany. Most of the students not only discover Germany but also get the opportunity to discover other countries in Europe. Thus, they become messengers of European diversity and ideals in the Middle East.

Collaboration with other non-German, European higher education institutions has grown in recent years thanks to GJU's participation in the prior ERASMUS Mundus EPIC ad AVEMPACE, as well as the EU TEMPUS programs. By the means of these academic exchanges, GJU seeks to fulfill its expressed goal to serve as a center for the incubation of a multicultural society in Jordan.
