

Ternopil National Economic University always strives to develop its international relationships and improve its educational and research activities. The university comprises of 7 faculties, 7 Institutes, 4 branches, and 3 colleges, where students representing 23 regions of Ukraine and 30 foreign countries study.

Overall there are 14 thousand students currently obtaining higher education degrees in all areas and specialties (majors) at the university.

The main areas of the University research pertain to the topics of economics and law, economic security and international economic relations, culture and computer science.

Each year, the University develops and implements international projects within programs such as Erasmus +, DAAD, Apollo, Horizon 2020, the International Visegrad Fund, L. Kirkland Programme and others.
