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	<p>Uzbekistan dated June 12, 2015 No. UP-4732, the Tashkent Institute of Architecture and Construction (TACI) is defined as a basic university for the organization of retraining and advanced training of university management and teaching staff in the architectural direction.</p> <p>There are the following basic needs (based on the need to fulfill the Development Strategy proposed by the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as the Decrees of the President of Uzbekistan on the development of higher education issued in 2017, 2018 to improve its quality, etc.):</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The need to train teachers in knowledge and skills in innovative tasks: integration of education with industry, sectors of the economy; strengthening of scientific potential, further development of university science, etc. 2. The need to establish direct international partnerships between universities of Uzbekistan and universities of EU countries; the need to adapt progressive European experience to the conditions and situations of universities in Uzbekistan. 3. The task set by the President of Uzbekistan, such as “Strengthening the spiritual and moral content of higher education”, necessitates an accelerated practical re-creation of relationships between mentors and their students on the principle of “Mentor-student”. The need to study the best practices of universities in EU countries in this direction. <p>Taking into account that the governing documents and principles on the organization of retraining and advanced training, management and teaching staff of universities in Uzbekistan were published in 2015. - until the Resolution of the President of Uzbekistan on the development of higher education appeared in 2017, 2018; The current development of processes for the implementation of these guidelines requires new approaches and, accordingly, new knowledge and skills, we can probably say that objectively including the current curriculum and curricula for retraining and advanced training courses of TACI need to be thoroughly revised and updated.</p>
