To SUPSI-DEASS partners

Dear partner of SUPSI/DSAN and/or SUPSI/DSAS,

as mentioned on the mail we sent you on the 06th October 2014, this year the Business Economics and Social Care Department (DSAS) and Health Department (DSAN) merged creating the Department of Business Economics, Health and Social Care (DEASS) which is officially operative from October 2014.

This year Swiss institutions are out of the Erasmus+ call 2015 as full partner.

Nevertheless, during a Swiss national agency workshop, it was explained that Swiss institutions can participate in the Erasmus+ 2015 projects with two options:

1. as "Third country" in the official application form. In this case the Swiss partner will be funded by European funds and its participation has to be really strategic and well motivated. After this, the Swiss partner is fully in the project since the application form as third country;
2. with the so called "Transitory solution". In this case the budget is on Swiss charge and a Swiss application form is needed (parallel to the European one with the same deadlines) filled by Swiss partner. In the official European application form, the Swiss partner has to be mentioned. After this, the Swiss partner is fully in the project since the application form, but financed by Swiss funds.

Hereby we would like to offer you our availability in being partner on proposals that you want to submit, in particular on KA2, both on Strategic Partnerships (deadline 31 March 2015) and on Knowledge Alliances/Sector Skills Alliances (deadline 26 February).

If you are willing to submit a project, we are fully available to evaluate the topic and, eventually, collaborate for this aim.
