Schools may apply for Erasmus+: Key Action 1 funding for their teachers to attend courses in the UK.
(Individual teachers may no longer apply for grants.)

Teachers with Erasmus+ funding and those paying with their own or other funds are welcome to apply for ISP courses.

The next annual Erasmus+ deadline will be in February or March 2015 for courses starting 01 July 2015 – 30 June 2016. Schools should first register on-line to obtain a Personal Identification Code (PIC) number for the school. Applications for funding should then be made on-line to applicants' National Agency for Erasmus+.
